**Directions:**

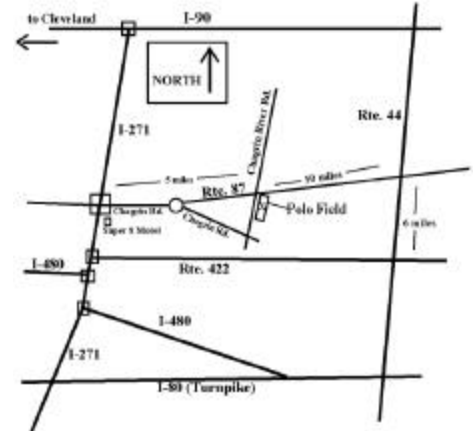
Get to Chagrin Road, head East. At the Lander circle, do not stay on Chagrin, take Rt. 87. This will be as if you'd gone 'straight' through the circle (not towards Orange High School). Following Rt. 87, you will go down a hill into the Chagrin River Valley. At the bottom is Chagrin River Road, turn right. The Polo Grounds are on your left, parking is at the far end of the field.

**Itinerary:**

- 9:30am – Captains Meeting for Round 0, Round 0 begins (bottom 8 teams play)
- 11:00am – Round 1 begins (16 team bracket – consolation rounds play)
- 12:00pm – Grilling begins
- 2:30pm – Quarterfinals begin
- 2:00pm – Semifinals begin
- 4:00pm – Finals (and heckling) begin

**Rules:**

- Consolation brackets should provide 2-3 games for all teams
- New Pull Rule (play in-bound pulls where they land) in effect
- 5M/2F ratio is the rule, captains are free to negotiate
- All players must be registered and payed
- Soft Cap means add two to highest score, play to that total
- Hard Cap means finish current point, if tied play one more, if not, end game
- 3 time outs, 2 allowed in any one half
- 9<sup>th</sup> Edition Rules applies otherwise



**Notes:**

- Teams should arrive **a half hour** before first scheduled game!
- No Bottles** on Polo Grounds (bottlecaps can harm horses' hooves)!

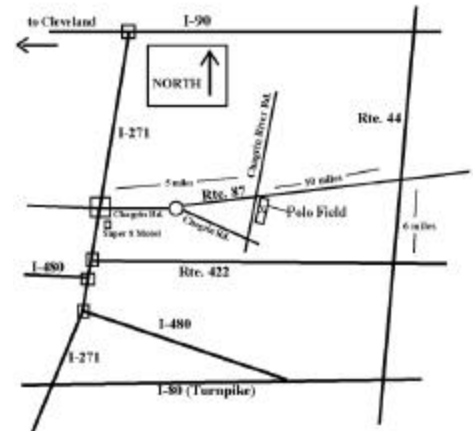
